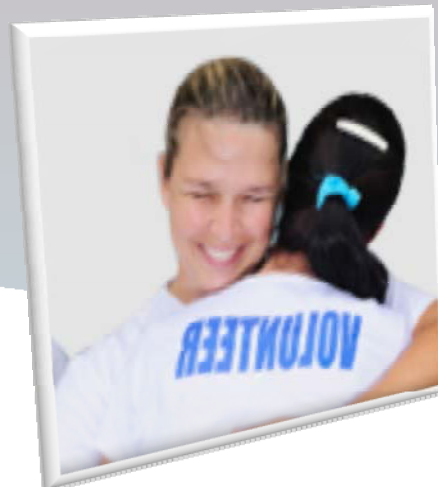


### Outreach
